Until the application deadline on April 30, applicants have to be nominated by their home university and their online application has to be submitted. The portfolio must also have reached us by that given deadline.

#### 2.3.2. Decision Response

We will send our decision within 5 weeks after the application deadline.

#### 2.3.3. Transcript of Records

Assuming that the incoming student has provided the International Office with all necessary information and documents, a Transcript of Records will be issued no later than 6 weeks after the assessment period has finished at our institution. The incoming students are responsible for their documents and for providing all necessary signatures in time.

#### 2.3.4. Termination of Agreement

The above parties agree on the present agreement and the activities listed therein replace any other previous agreement. For each academic year, both parties will have the opportunity to review the exchanges. After having notified the partner institution, and if agreed by that institution, amendments of the mobility figures can be made on an annual basis.

In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

## 3.1. Grading System

No grades in use. Teaching staff certifies successful completion of educational components by signature. The regular workload of one semester equals 30 ECTS credits.

# 3.2. Visa
