

Residence NRW⁺: *Grants for Visual Artists*

1/10/2024 – 30/9/2025

The Residence NRW⁺ programme will once again award four scholarships for visual artists for 2024/2025, following its successful launch in Münster in 2020. The fellowship, which lasts for 12 months from 1 October 2024 to 30 September 2025, is exclusively available to up-and-coming artists who have completed professional artistic training, such as an art academy or university, and have a connection to the federal state of North Rhine-Westphalia. To be eligible for the fellowship starting on 1 October 2024, recipients must have completed their artistic training within the last five years or be under the age of 40.

Residence NRW⁺ is a confidently funded initiative of the City of Münster, supported by the Ministry of Culture and Science of the State of North Rhine-Westphalia, the Kunststiftung NRW, and the Swiss Arts Council Pro Helvetia. The programme is associated with the Kunsthalle Münster, and is based on proven methods for promoting talented young artists and curators. These methods were successfully developed and tested on a project basis between 2001 and 2018 at Schloss Ringenberg on the Lower Rhine.

Six fellowship holders, four artists, and one curator from NRW, as well as one curator from Switzerland, will reside concurrently in the city of Münster. Münster boasts several renowned production and presentation venues for contemporary art, such as the Kunstakademie Münster, various studio houses, the Kunsthalle Münster, the Westfälischer Kunstverein, and the LWL-Museum für Kunst und Kultur. These venues exhibit contemporary art at the highest level and serve as a platform for discussing the latest international trends in the field, engaging with a broad audience.

During the scholarship period, all fellows live and work together in a building specially adapted and renewed for this purpose on the grounds of Hoppengarten, a new cultural quarter close to the city center. Based on the four key elements of the programme – exchange, practice, support, and networking – Residence NRW⁺ provides optimal conditions for advancement within each individual field of work: artists and curators live and work together under one roof. Furthermore, a qualified person with long-term experience in the field will mentor the curators.

The residency location provides an ideal environment for concentration. Moreover, the fellowship offers a generous monthly allowance of 1,700 euros, which covers both living expenses (1,500 euros) and production costs (200 euros). Upon completion of the scholarship in 2024/2025, there will be a subsidised exhibition at the NAK Neuer Aachener Kunstverein (September 23 – October 26, 2025). This opportunity will undoubtedly enable artists to refine their individual concerns and approaches with confidence and authority.

The fellowship is primarily spent at the place of residence in Münster. Participation in the Residence NRW⁺ programme is a prerequisite for taking up the fellowship. Basic knowledge of the German language would be beneficial.

Please note that all application documents, including the application form, portfolio, and catalogues, must be submitted in hard copy. Furthermore, work samples such as film, video, and performance can be attached to the printout on a USB stick.

To ensure the return of your application documents, please make sure to tick the 'return documents' box on the application form and enclose the documents in appropriate return packaging with sufficient postage already addressed.

We collect the following information from you:

Recipients of data or categories of recipients of personal data / disclosure of data to third parties: Your personal data will not be transmitted to third parties for purposes other than the following:

- Manual or automated data synchronization with Merle Radtke as director for Kunsthalle Münster, Marcus Lütkemeyer as director of the Residence NRW+ programme as well as with the respective members of the independent jury (experts in the field of contemporary art: curators of museums and art associations, artists, art professors) to fulfil the application requirements and to give out the advertised grants
- Transmission of form of address, first name, surname, application documents (grant as visual artist, with data concerning artistic projects, CV, participation in exhibitions, bibliography) to members of the jury as part of the selection process

In the case of being selected for the programme:

- Manual or automated data synchronization with the accounting department (Kulturamt) and the Stadtkasse Münster for the purpose of paying out the grant as well as the payment of reimbursements / allowances

Duration of storage:

The personal data (address, bank details) collected by the City of Münster will be deleted by the person responsible after the completion of the programme. Data concerning artistic projects, CV, participation in exhibitions, and bibliography as well as phone number, email address and link to a website is used to expand the network of graduates and will only be deleted after the dissolution of the Residence NRW+ programme.

Rights of the data subject:

- Right to information about stored personal data relating to you and their processing pursuant to Art. 15 GDPR
- Right to correction of data in the event that your data should be inaccurate or incomplete, pursuant to Art. 16 GDPR
- Right to deletion of stored personal data relating to you if one of the requirements under Art. 17 GDPR applies. In addition to the exceptions listed under Art. 17 (3) GDPR, the right to deletion does not exist if deletion is impossible or only possible with disproportionate effort due to the special manner of storage. In such cases, deletion shall be replaced by restriction of the processing pursuant to Art. 18 GDPR.
- Right to restriction of the processing pursuant to Art. 18 GDPR
- The right pursuant to Article 20 GDPR to receive the personal data that you have provided to us in a structured, common and machine-readable format or to request that it be transferred to another data controller.
- Right of objection against certain data processing measures pursuant to Art. 21 GDPR
- These rights may be restricted pursuant to Art. 23 GDPR. Federal and state legislative authorities have made use of this possibility to restrict the rights of the data subject. If you make use of the above-mentioned rights, the City of Münster will check whether the legal requirements for this are met in your individual case.

Right of appeal to the supervisory authority:

If you are of the opinion that your personal data is being processed in an unlawful manner, you can lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authority.
