

Fact sheet:

Free Movers

(as defined in §19 Section 2 of the Registration and Auditing Student Regulations of the Hochschule für bildende Künste Hamburg, 14.07.2007 in the respectively current version)

Depending on the availability of study workplace capacity, the HFBK may enroll persons from other universities, academies, and colleges with whom no cooperation agreement exists and who do not wish to study at the HFBK in the context of national and international exchange and mobility programmes at the HFBK as so-called Free Movers.

In principle, study achievements can be accumulated and, if applicable, be recognised at your own home institution.

As a free mover, you must pay the semester contribution for the semester in question in full. The semester contribution includes a semester ticket for the Hamburg public transport. You will be informed upon your admission as a free mover regarding the payment of the semester contribution.

Application periods

Applications for the **summer semester** must be made by the **15th of April**, and applications for the **winter semester** must be made by the **15th of October**. Applications received after the dates given here cannot be considered.

Which documents are to be submitted?

- 1.) A filled-out free mover application signed by a professor (**also required for extension of free mover place**)
- 2.) A CV written by yourself, including prior education and any artistic activity
- 3.) 1 passport photo, which must have the name written on the reverse side
- 4.) A brief free-form explanation of your reasons for applying for a free mover place

The decision on admittance will ultimately be made by the Präsidium committee, depending on the availability of study places.

Where should the application be submitted?

The application, together with all the required documents, should be submitted to Room 01, Wartenau 15 during opening times, or by post to the Students Service Office.

Please note: We can only consider applications that contain all the necessary documents.
