

# **Decree of the payment of a session fee to student members for the participation in self-administrative bodies of Hochschule für bildende Künste Hamburg**

## **Preamble**

In accordance with §9 section 4 sentence 2 Hamburgischen Hochschulgesetzes (HmbHG) provision is to be made for students who are active in self-government to be compensated by session fees as a considerable time burden is usually associated with the activity in a body. The present decree regulates the implementation of this provision at the Hochschule für bildende Künste Hamburg.

## **§ 1 Session fees**

(1) Student members of the following bodies, which are bodies of academic self-administration prescribed by the Hochschulgesetz, receive a session fee of 30 € per meeting for their honorary work within the limits of the available budget. The compensation is granted without legal entitlement. The bodies of academic self-administration include:

- University Senate
- Department Committees
- Admission Examination Board
- Appeals Commission
- General Audit Committee
- Election Committee
- Election Review Committee
- Opposition Committee
- PhD Committee
- Quality Assessment
- Steering Group for Quality Assessment
- Steering Group for Diversity.

(2) Compensation for activities in bodies or committees not mentioned is excluded. Individual activities are not eligible for compensation.

(3) Deputy members receive a corresponding session fee only if they represent the main member.

(4) A session fee for a meeting is only granted if the member – or in the case of a deputy, his/her deputy – was present for more than 2/3 of the duration of the meeting.

(5) The session fee according to these regulations must be claimed at the latest one month after the end of each semester. A session fee that is not claimed in time will be forfeited. The compensation payments (session fees) are to be applied for at the committee supervisor of the HFBK Hamburg and will only be paid on the basis of the recorded participation.

## **§ 2 Effective date**

This order shall take effect on 06/22/2023.
