Scholarships for Exchange Semesters



Supported by funding through the Erasmus+ (EU) and PROMOS (DAAD) mobility programs

HFBK students from the departments of **Design, Painting/Drawing, Photography, Sculpture, Stage Design** and **Time-based Media** and are eligible to apply for a study abroad period at one of the following partner universities within the framework of the Art School Alliance in the **winter semester 2027–28***:

- Akademie der bildenden Künste, Vienna
- Bard College, Annandale-on-Hudson/New York State
- Beaux-Arts de Paris
- Bezalel Academy of Arts and Design, Jerusalem
- California Institute of the Arts, Los Angeles
- China Academy of Art, Hangzhou
- Department of Art, Goldsmiths, University of London
- Margaret Trowell School of Industrial and Fine Arts, Makerere University, Kampala
- School of the Museum of Fine Arts, Tufts University, Boston
- School of Art+Design, Purchase College, New York

In addition, for students of the Film Department only, the following partner university is available in winter semester 2027/28:

- Universidad del Cine, Buenos Aires

Exceptionally, students from all departments may apply for an ASA study period already in **summer semester 2027*** at the following partner institution:

- School of Art, University of Haifa
- Faculty of Arts, Department of Creative Arts, University of Lagos

The scholarship holders may study at the partner universities for one semester. Tuition fees are waived, and they receive reimbursement of travel expenses as well as a monthly financial grant. The **semester dates*** at the partner institutions only roughly correspond to those of the HFBK and may differ by several weeks.

- Cover page including a motivation letter (upload*)
- Portfolio with a selection of works (upload*)
- Letter of recommendation from an HFBK professor (upload*)

*After successfully submitting the online application form, the cover page with motivation letter, portfolio, and recommendation letter must be uploaded as one PDF file (max. 10 MB) named: Surname_Firstname.pdf
